

Day Camp Van Pick Up and Drop Off Locations

Children need to bring a water bottle, lunch, snacks and drinks. They will also need to bring a swimsuit, towel and sunscreen. A concession stand is open on site if they wish to bring quarters to purchase snacks.

ABOUT DAY CAMP:

One does not need to be a member of Camp Fire North Texas in order to attend day camp. Any youth in kindergarten (who will be 5 by September 1) through junior high can attend.

Camp Fire Day Camp is arranged in small groups of 8 to 15 campers who are supervised by an adult counselor who is assisted by a high schoolaged junior counselor. Camp activities are conducted in the spacious lodge as well as under the large trees scattered throughout the park. Tree houses are nestled high among the trees, and campers eagerly await their turn for lunchtime in a tree house. Camp Fire's privately owned, 16 acre Harrell Park also includes the Gladys Marie Murph building, the rustic Friendship Cabin, soccer fields, games area, sand exercise area, a covered pavilion and colorful playground equipment.

A nurse is on duty and a doctor is on call.

Accident insurance is carried on all campers.

The fee for each camp session is \$100. There is a one-time registration fee of \$15 for non-members.

The Camp Director is onsite at 7:45AM for early drop off at Harrell Park.

Once day camp is dismissed at 4 PM, campers may stay at the pool until 6 PM for an additional \$10 per week (or \$2 per day). This service is offered for the convenience of those parents who need to pick up campers after work. The camp director is at Harrell Park at 7:45 AM for early arrivals.

[A refund of camp fees is made only if requested by letter stating the family has moved from the council area or by a doctor's verification of a camper's illness.](#)

Day Camp Registration Information

**Day Camp Registration is open starting Friday April 1st.
Camp Hours 8:30AM - 4:00PM**

We ask that you register your child in person or online by Wednesday June 1st.

The cost of one week of Camp Fire Day Camp is \$100.

Payments are due the Friday prior to the week of attendance.

To register your child, stop in at the Camp Fire office and fill out the registration form. The first week's payment is due the Friday prior to the week of camp your child is attending (June 3 for Session 1, June 10 for Session 2, and June 17 for Session 3). You can also register your child online at campfirentx.org, under Programs, select Day Camp. You can also register your child as a Junior Counselor - they must be 14 or have completed the 8th grade - just select Day Camp Junior Counselor on the website.

Some financial assistance can be awarded to those in need or payment plans can be arranged.

If you are unable to pay the normal weekly camper fee, please contact Tamara Higginbotham at the Camp Fire office to setup an appointment for Campership eligibility. You will need to bring a copy of your W-2 or your last two pay stubs for income verification.

The payment for the first week of camp is due at the time of campership approval. Your child's registration will be on hold until the payment has been made.

Camperships are limited.

Camperships are awarded on a first come, first serve basis and there is a \$25.00 minimum fee for each week.
